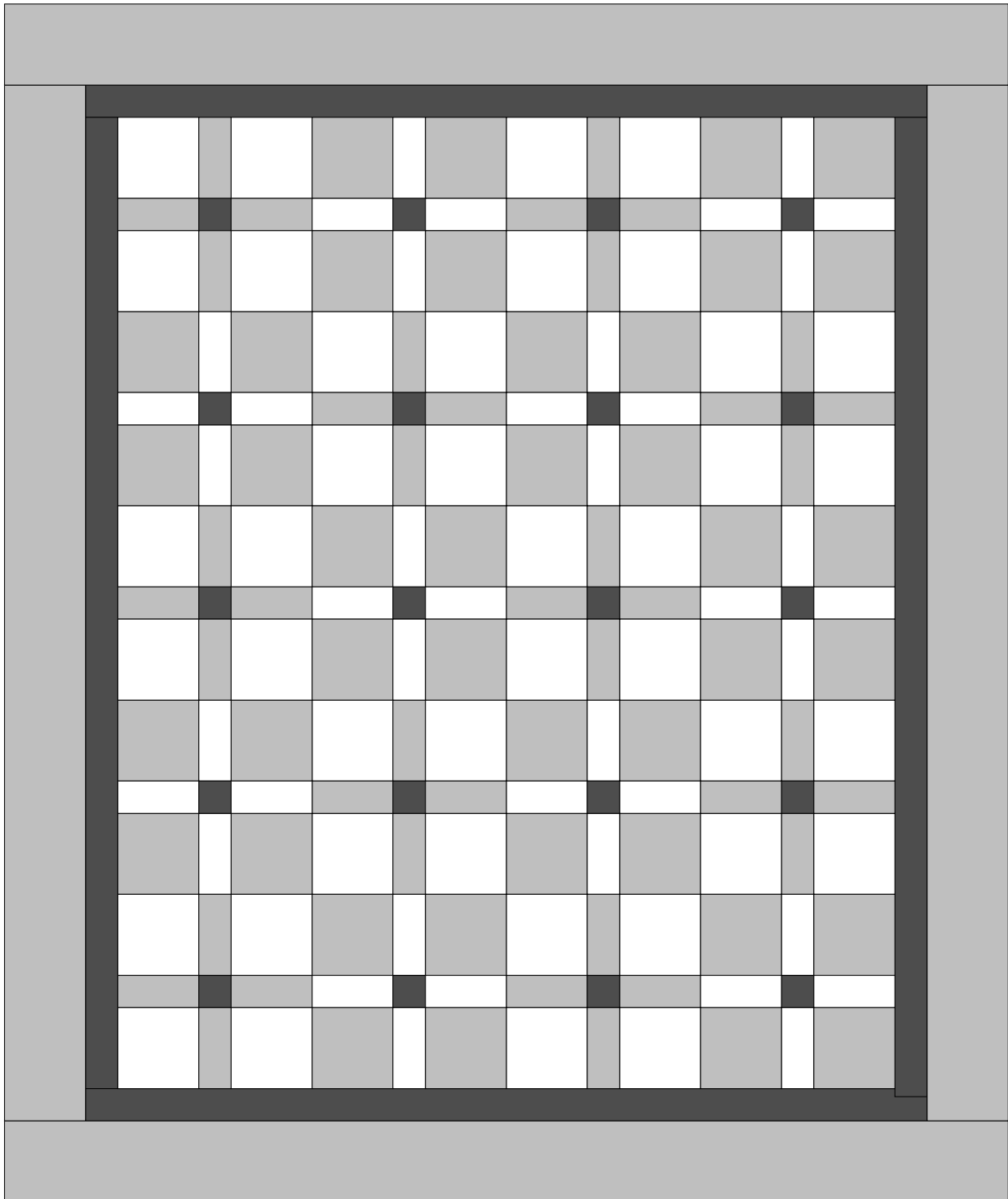


Uneven Nine Patch Quilt

Approximate finished size 65 x 77 inches

Uneven 9 Patch

Fabrics needed:

WOF = width of fabric

Blocks

Light—2 yards fabric

Cut into 8—5½ inch X WOF strips

Cut into 3—2½ inch X WOF strips

Dark—2 yards fabric

Cut into 8—5½ inch X WOF strips

Cut into 3—2½ inch X WOF strips

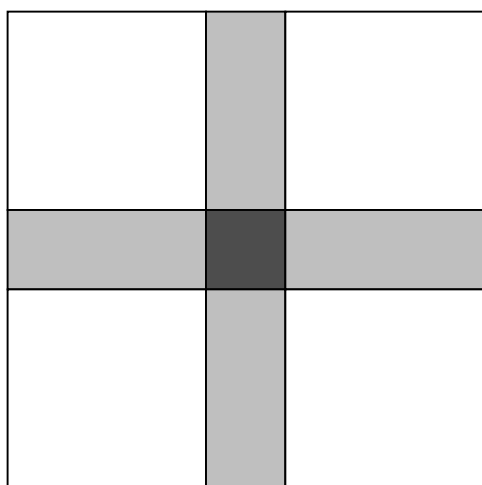
Accent (includes Inner Border) ¾ yard fabric

Cut into 8—2½ inch X WOF strips

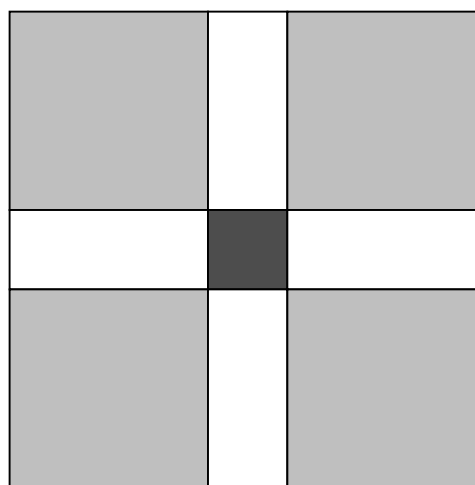
Reserve 6 strips for Inner Border

Outer Border - 1 yard fabric, cut into 6—5½ inch X WOF strips

Binding - ½ yard, cut into 6 WOF strips, the width needed for your method of binding.



Block A - Make 10

Uneven 9 Patch

BLOCK A CONSTRUCTION

All seams are 1/4 inch

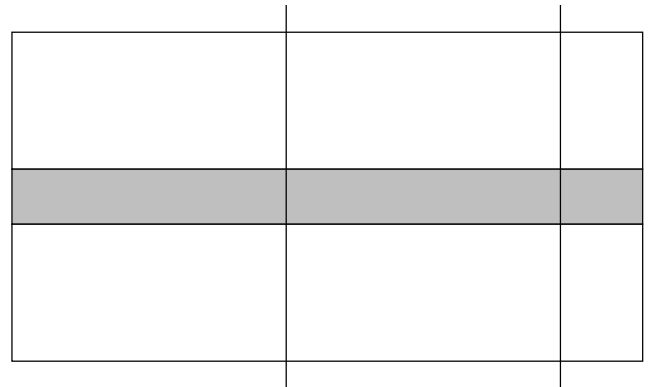
Take 1 DARK fabric, 2½ x wof strip and place it between 2 LIGHT fabric, 5½ inch x wof strips as shown at the right.

Stitch together along the long edges and press seams toward the darker fabric.

Make 3 strips.

Cut into 20, 5½ inch units.

Place in two piles of 10 units each.



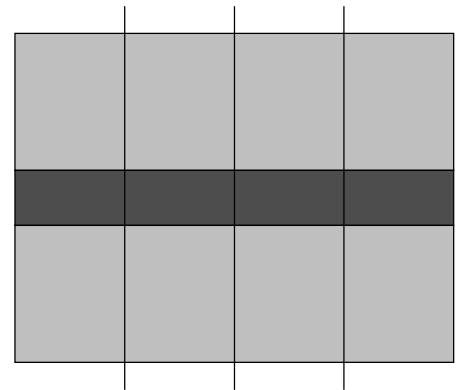
Cut into 20, 5½ inch units

Take 1 ACCENT fabric, 2½ inch x wof strip between 2 DARK, 5½ inch x wof strips as shown at the right.

Stitch together along the long edges and press seams toward the darker fabric.

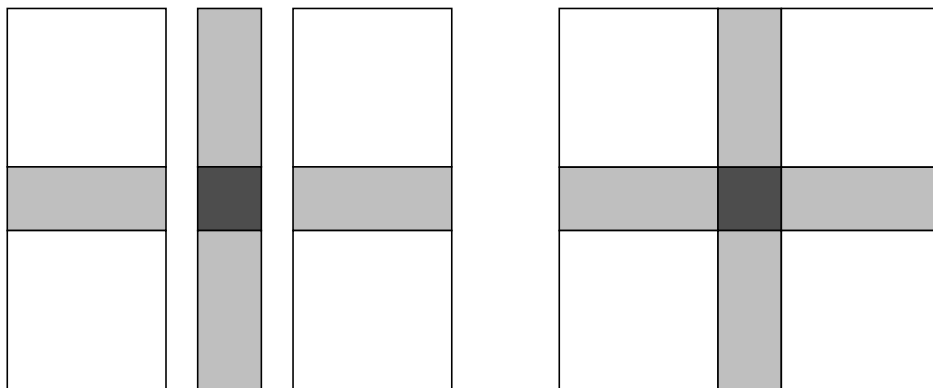
Make 1 strip.

Cut into 10, 2½ inch units.



Cut into 10, 2½ inch units

Stitch the pieces together as shown below. Press seams towards the dark fabric.



Block A is complete and should measure 12½ x 12½ inches, which includes seam allowances.

Uneven 9 Patch

BLOCK B CONSTRUCTION

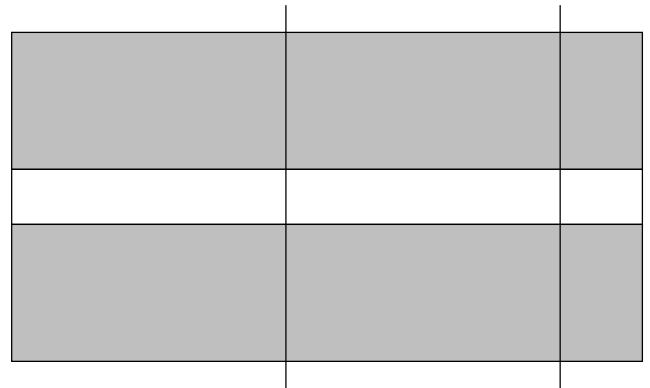
Take 1 LIGHT fabric, $2\frac{1}{2}$ x wof strip and place it between 2 DARK fabric, $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch x wof strips as shown at the right.

Stitch together along the long edges and press seams toward the darker fabric.

Make 3 strips.

Cut into 20, $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch units.

Place in two piles of 10 units each.



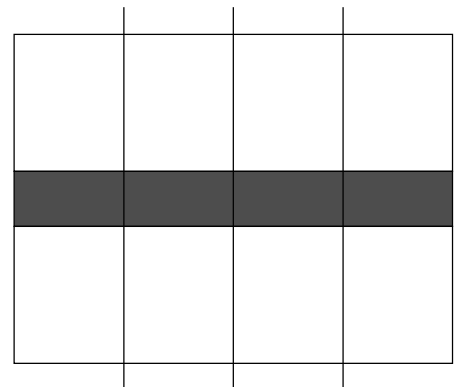
Cut into 20, $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch units

Take 1 ACCENT fabric, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch x wof strip between 2 LIGHT, $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch x wof strips as shown at the right.

Stitch together along the long edges and press seams toward the darker fabric.

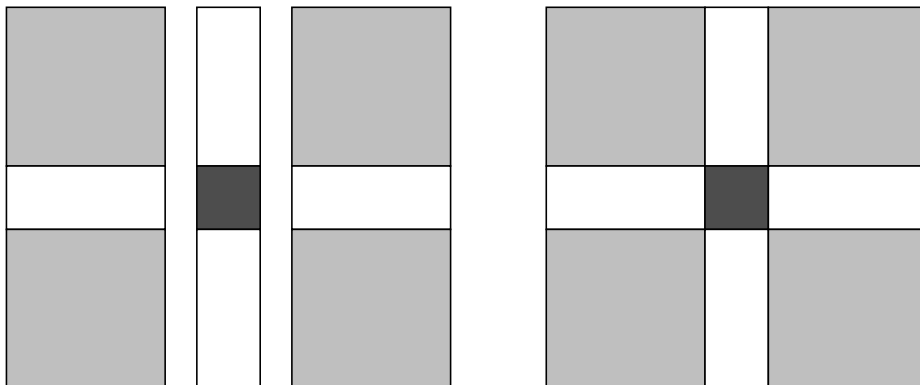
Make 1 strip.

Cut into 10, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch units.



Cut into 10, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch units

Stitch the pieces together as shown below. Press seams towards the dark fabric.



Block B is complete and should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ x $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches, which includes seam allowances.

Uneven 9 Patch

Place **Block A** and **Block B** as shown below. Stitch together to make the quilt top. Press seams as desired.

Use the remaining ACCENT fabric, 2½ inch x wof strips and add the **Inner Border**.

Use the remaining DARK fabric, 5½ inch x wof strips and add the **Outer Border**.

The quilt top is now completed and is ready to be quilted.
